Science Projects

1. Prepare working model on the topics given below

- a) Create a water filtration system using sand gravel and cotton etc. (Roll no. 1 to 5)
- b) Create balloon rocket showing Newton's law. (Roll no.6 to 10)
- c) Prepare a periscope using cardboard and mirror to demonstrate reflection.(Roll no. 11 to 15)
- d) Prepare rainwater detector system (Roll no.16 to 20)
- e) Make simple air pollution detector system (Roll no.21 to 25)
- f) Prepare an electromagnet using wire, battery, switch etc. (Roll no. 26 to 30)
- g) Prepare hydraulic lift model using syringes and tubes to demonstrate Pascal law. (Roll no. 31-36)

- Collect 5 to 10 interesting science news and summarise them
- Include topics like climate change, space exploration or new discoveries
- Illustrate with pictures or diagrams.

Make collage on simple machines in daily life and applications of chemistry at home on A4 size sheet.
